
- Availability: Mondays to Thursdays during the school term

Supervision & Requirements

- Maximum of 24 students per session (6 players per simulator).
- Teacher or staff supervision required throughout.
- Schools arrange their own transport to and from Status Golf.
- Students must wear covered shoes and comfortable attire (e.g., PE uniform).
- All Status Golf staff hold current Working with Vulnerable People registration.
- Bus & coach parking available on Akuna St opposite Glebe Park approx. 2 minutes' walk to Status Golf.
